Pat Barnes provided a handout which contained meeting agenda, minutes from previous meeting, and the "Golf Classic 2008" flyer.
2. Secretary's Report. The previous meeting's minutes, referred to above, were accepted with the single modification of adding "ASABE" to the blank in Paragraph 5.
